	Question	Answer
1	Does Algonquin carry appropriate insurance to cover ANY event (ie. damage to crops, buildings, persons) that may occur on the leased land or on non-leased land but caused by the turbine erected on the leased land, over the life of the project? If not, who is the responsible party?	Yes – robust insurance is in place by Windlectric to cover items in connection to equipment, personnel and property related to the wind project on leased lands.
2	Will the landowners receive benefit from the power produced by turbines on the land they have leased to the turbine company? What is that benefit?	Power produced by the wind farm is fed directly into the grid via the marine cable running from the island over to the mainland where the connection point is through the Switching Station located on the Invista property.
3	When the project is finished and all remediation's completed, who will be in charge of the project and who will monitor the day to day functioning of the turbines? Who will be employed to handle disputes/complaints? How many of these people will be islanders? Have these jobs been allocated? Names?	When the project is complete the operations team will manage the facility. The operations team will consist of representatives of Windlectric and Siemens managing the day to day technical matters as well as complaints and commercial matters. Preference is to hire qualified local candidates whenever possible.
4	When the project is completed, will the company ferry dock be decommissioned and dismantled? If not, how will it be maintained and used?	When the project is complete the Mainland dock will be removed. The island dock will be reduced in length by approximately two/thirds.
5	Can we expect the CEO of Algonquin to be present at the "Grand Opening" of the project? When might that be?	As this time no date has been set for the ceremonial opening of the Wind Farm.
6	When is the commercial operation of the project?	The project will achieve commercial operation in the second quarter of 2018.
7	What ongoing work will there be post construction?	Post construction vehicle operation will be limited to work associated with remediation requirements along public haul routes (ie: shoulder cleanups) and private access roads and turbine sites. Post remediation, minor private access road maintenance will occur as required, including snow ploughing.
